

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Supply List

## Community Property (no need to label individually)

36- #2 Ticonderoga Pencils (sharpened). The cheap pencils are quickly eaten by the pencil sharpener they are a waste of your money.

4 large pink erasers

Package of eraser caps

1 package of 4x4 graph paper

2 Black Dry erase markers

1 pkg. – 12 count colored pencils – sharpened

1 yellow highlighter

1 glue stick

1 large bag M&M's (plain or peanut) (girls bring)

1 large bag Skittles (boys bring)

1 box of crackers – cheez-it or goldfish

1 large bag Individually wrapped Candy (whatever your child prefers)

1-2 boxes tissues

## Individual Supplies (please label with child's name)

2 hand pencil sharpeners – with top to collect shavings (labeled)

1 package of washable markers (no more than 12 markers)

1 pencil box

1 pkg.– 24 count Crayons (NOT larger sizes)

Sharp-pointed children's scissors (labeled!)

12 inch ruler – must have metric markings

1 accordion organizer (durable) with 7-10 pockets (not the larger sizes)

3 Composition notebooks – wide ruled (not spiral)

1 plain yellow plastic folders with pockets and brads

1 - 3 ring plastic/flexible binder

1 milk crate

### Optional items:

Roll of paper towels

Antibacterial hand wipes

Ziploc bags

Microwave popcorn

### Supplies for English:

1 package (150 sheets) of wide ruled notebook paper.

300 ruled index cards (3x5 size)

### Supplies for History:

1 – 12 count package of colored pencils (sharpened) (designated just for history)
