1 soft <u>plastic</u> folder, RED , with pockets. This is for HOMEWORK. <i>It needs to be plastic</i>
to last. Label with your student's name on the front.
<u>REUSABLE</u> water bottle for your child to keep at their desk during the week
1 New King James Bible - sturdy, with <u>larger font</u> so your child can follow better. <u>Labe</u>
with your student's name.
1 <u>sturdy</u> letter size <u>accordion organizer</u> with <u>at least 10 pockets</u> . Please provide your
students with a quality, <u>durable organizer</u> because it will be used <u>daily</u> . Label tabs as
follows BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL: Bible, English, Writing, Science,

a Dictionary AND a Thesaurus (sturdy - we'll use these a lot!)


